Questions and Answers

1. Q: For those of us who have been appointed minor's counsel under the FL3150 for years, do we need to respond and apply to the RFI?
A: Yes, the Court encourages those who are interested to respond and apply to the RFI.
2. Q: Why did the Court issue an RFI for minor's counsel?
A: The Court is wanting to enter into a contract with one or more attorney's and control the costs as funding is limited.
3. Q: Who can apply? Sole Proprietor and Corporate?
A: See §1.2 of the RFI. *All legal service providers, including but not limited to, solo practitioners and partnerships; government agencies; non-profit organizations; private firms; panel organizational configurations; and any combination thereof are invited to submit their information.*
4. Q: What does the court intend to do with cases already appointed?
A: Once the Court received all of the requests from those who are interested, the court will review each of them and make a determination how to address the existing cases.
