There are several county and state-wide resources available to ensure citizens are able to vote.

Merced County Resources

- The **Merced County Elections Office** website, which can be accessed at: <https://www.co.merced.ca.us/225/Elections>, provides the hours and locations of all Voting Assistance Centers and Official Ballot Drop Box locations as well as ballot tracking and up-to-date county results.
- Voting Assistance Centers services include ballot drop-off, provisional and conditional voting, ballot replacement, accessible voting, and language services.
- The early Voting Assistance Centers are operating in Merced County starting Saturday, May 28, 2022, through Friday, June 3, 2022. All locations are operating beginning Saturday, June 4 through Tuesday, June 7, 2022.
