Merced Superior Court Modifies Operations

On March 17, 2020, the Merced Superior Court (Court) announced its plan to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19, which included a number of court operational changes. Court administration has been carefully monitoring the advice of public, state and federal health officials regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. The goal of the Merced Superior Court during this unprecedented situation is to protect the safety, health and welfare of court customers, jurors and staff.

Effective May 2, 2022, the Court is modifying current operations. Below is a summary of Clerk's Office hours and court operations.

Courthouse Entry

1. Face coverings may be worn on a voluntary basis.
2. Do not come to the court if in the last 10 days you have tested positive for COVID-19 and are under quarantine, are awaiting test results due to an exposure to or symptoms of COVID-19 or are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. If you are represented by an attorney, please contact your attorney prior to coming to court to determine whether you need to appear in person. In most instances, your attorney can appear for you. If you do not have an attorney, you may contact the Clerk's Office.
3. Remote appearances are encouraged to the extent possible and may be required in some proceedings. See the "Remote Appearances" tab at www.merced.courts.ca.gov for more information.
