## UPDATED NOTICE REGARDING PUBLIC ACCESS

Merced Superior Court is committed to continuing to serve the public and ensure continued court operations while also taking appropriate proactive and responsive measures to protect the safety, health, and welfare of court customers, jurors, and staff. To this end, we request that individuals refrain from visiting the Court whenever possible, and take advantage of the many remote services available, as detailed below.

If you must be physically present at court facilities, we will require that you take reasonable precautions to protect against the spread of COVID-19 by wearing a face shield or mask, washing/sanitizing hands often, and socially distancing.

**Clerk's Offices** – The Clerk's Offices remain open for all filings Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Exception: Merced Traffic is open 7:30 am to 3:00 pm Monday through Friday.

**Drop-Boxes** – Available at all court locations. Documents deposited before 4:00 pm on business days will be processed the same day.

### Court Proceedings

**Parties** – In-person appearance may be permitted; however, remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be required in some courtrooms.

**Observers** – Public access to court proceedings is available through in person access or livestream, which can be accessed on the Court's website at [www.mercedcourt.org](http://www.mercedcourt.org). Certain proceedings, including criminal trials and preliminary hearings may not be available via livestream. Seating is available to view criminal trials and preliminary hearings in person.

**Media** – Normal procedures apply.
