Merced Superior Court Modifies Operations

On March 17, 2020, the Merced Superior Court (Court) announced its plan to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19, which included a number of court operational changes. On March 21, 2020 the Court announced further operational changes. Court administration has been carefully monitoring the advice of public, state and federal health officials regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. The Court is modifying its operations.

The goal of the Merced Superior Court during this unprecedented situation is to protect the safety, health and welfare of court customers, jurors and staff. To this end, we request that individuals refrain from visiting the Court whenever possible.

The Clerk's Offices remain open for all filings Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Exception: Merced Traffic is open 7:30 am to 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Please see the clerk's office notice on the Court's website www.mercedcourt.org for detailed hours and drop box locations.

Telephone hours are from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Drop-box filings are processed throughout the day. Exception: Merced Traffic will answer telephones from 7:30 am to 3:00 pm Monday – Friday.

Court operations will continue with remote appearances strongly encouraged. Entry to court facilities are subject to screening requirements.

1. Only parties and attorneys required to appear in a court hearing will be permitted to enter the court facilities on the day of the hearing after submitting to screening and absent any signs of illness. Do not bring friends or family members with you as they will not be permitted inside the buildings.
2. Limited seating is available for in-person observations of criminal jury trials and preliminary hearings. Additional limited accommodations are available for remote trial or preliminary hearing observations.
3. All persons entering the court facilities shall wear a face covering or face mask while in any Merced Court facility unless otherwise ordered by a judicial officer.

4. All persons entering a Merced Court facility shall submit to a non-invasive temperature screening process and SHALL NOT enter if a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher is detected. Those not permitted to enter the court facilities should contact their attorney or the clerk's office if not represented by an attorney.
5. Do not come to the court if you are ill and experiencing flu-like symptoms or have a fever or cough. Do not come to the court if you have a scheduled appointment for COVID testing, have tested positive or likely have COVID-19. Do not come to the court if you've been exposed to someone who has tested positive or are in quarantine. If you are represented by an attorney, please contact your attorney prior to coming to court to determine whether you need to appear in person. In most instances, your attorney can appear for you. If you do not have an attorney, you may contact the Clerk's Offices listed below. Telephones are answered Monday - Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. The Merced Traffic office answers telephones Monday - Friday from 7:30 am to 3:00 pm

Operations Update

Civil Operations (including Juvenile Dependency) – (209) 725-4111

- Clerk's Office hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm Monday - Friday
- Courtroom 8 combined with Courtroom 10 (Unlimited Civil, Juvenile Dependency and Probate) will continue with hearings as scheduled in Courtroom 10. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be required in some proceedings. In-person access is limited to allow for social distancing.
- Courtroom 9 - Limited Civil and Small Claims hearings will continue as scheduled. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged, and in-person access is limited to allow for social distancing.

Criminal Operations – (209) 725-4113

- Clerk's Office hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm Monday – Friday
- Courtrooms 1, 2, 3 and 6 –Felony/Specialty Criminal calendars will continue as scheduled. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with limited in-person appearances allowed.

- Courtrooms 4 and 5 – Misdemeanor calendars will continue as scheduled. PC 977 and remote appearances are strongly encouraged with limited in-person appearances allowed.

Family Law Operations – (209) 725-4117

- Clerk’s Office hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm Monday - Friday
- Courtroom 7 – Family Law calendars will be heard in-person unless the party and/or their attorney notify the Court of their intention to appear remotely. See the “Remote Appearances Tab” on the website for more information.
- Courtroom 4 – DCSS and DV calendars will continue to be heard as scheduled. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with limited in-person access to allow for social distancing.
- Family Court Services - Child Custody Recommending Counseling will remain remote.

Juvenile Delinquency Operations – (209) 725-4119

- Courtroom 11 – Juvenile Delinquency calendars remain as scheduled at Juvenile Hall. Remote appearances only unless otherwise permitted by the Judicial Officer.

- Courtroom 12 - Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be required in some proceedings. Preliminary hearings permitted in the courtroom at Judicial Officer discretion. A limited number of individuals who appear at the courthouse may be permitted to use the courthouse terminals to participate in remote hearings.
- Courtroom 13 Family Law matters (every 2nd and 4th Tuesday). Family Law calendars will be heard in-person unless the party and/or their attorney notify the Court of their intention to appear remotely see the “Remote Appearances Tab” at www.mercedcourt.org for more information. In-person access is limited to allow for social distancing.

Courtroom Operations Update

Courtrooms 1 - 6:

1. Courtroom seating is limited to allow for social distancing.
2. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with in-person access limited to allow for social distancing.

Courtroom 7:

1. In-person access is limited to allow for social distancing. Parties may request remote appearances.

627 W. 21st Street, Merced, CA Courthouse:

Courtroom 8:

1. Courtroom 8 will continue to be combined with Courtroom 10. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be requested or required. In-person access limited to allow for social distancing.

Courtroom 9:

1. Contact the Traffic Division to schedule your hearings, including walk-in arraignments. Provide the Clerk's Office with your phone number for telephonic appearances.
2. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be requested. Courtroom seating is limited to allow for social distancing.

Courtroom 10:

1. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be requested or required in some proceedings. In-person access is limited to allow for social distancing.
2. Courtroom 8 calendars will continue to be heard in Courtroom 10.

Courtroom 11:

1. Juvenile Delinquency calendars remain as scheduled at Juvenile Hall. Privacy requirements dictate that only individuals involved in a given case may be present when that case is proceeding. Remote appearances only unless in person appearances are authorized by the judicial officer.

1159 "G" Street, Los Banos, CA Courthouse:

Courtroom 12:

1. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and may be required in some proceedings. In-person access is limited to allow for social distancing at judicial officer discretion.

Courtroom 13:

1. In-person access is limited to allow for social distancing. Parties may request remote appearances.

Jury Service – (209) 725-4121

- Hours of operation: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm

Jury service will continue. Be assured that we are working with the County Health Department to ensure your safety. The court has installed hand sanitizing stations throughout the facilities and social distancing is observed. Additional precautionary measures include temperature scanning, batching smaller reporting groups and staggering the reporting times to allow for entry screening.
