Motion for Entry of Judgement

On November 21, 2024, the parties filed a stipulation to set aside the default judgment entered against the defendants which was approved by the Court and an order entered on January 24, 2025, pursuant to the stipulation. At the time of the hearing, on November 25, 2024, the Court further ordered, by way of tentative ruling which was adopted, that the matter be set for a trial setting conference on June 9, 2025, and that the defendants file an answer to the complaint by December 15, 2024.

Defendant filed an answer on January 7, 2025, roughly six weeks after the deadline given by the Court's order. The clerk of the court accepted the answer. Since the answer was filed on January 7, 2025, Plaintiff has not sought reconsideration of the November 25, 2024, order or otherwise objected to the answer filed on January 7, 2025, until filing a reply to the opposition to the request for court judgment on May 30, 2025. Defendant has never brought a motion to set aside the underlying default, nor was such an order contained in the stipulation.

Although a default that has not been set aside would generally preclude a defendant from appearing in a case, in quiet title actions, a defaulting defendant is generally entitled to participate in an open-court evidentiary hearing to determine the merits of the quiet title claim. (See, e.g., *Nickell v. Matlock* (2012) 206 Cal.App.4th 934, 942, 947; *Harbour Vista LLC v. HSBC Mortgage Services, Inc.* (2011) 201 Cal.App.4th 1496, 1503-1504; *Paterra v. Hansen* (2021) 64 Cal.App.5th 507, 532-533; *Bailey v. Citibank N.A.* (2021) 66 Cal.App.5th 335, 347; see also, Code Civ. Proc. § 764.010.)
