The instant motion is not premature given the requirement that a court order is required to take the deposition of an attorney for an opposing party. (See e.g. *Carehouse Convalescent Hospital v. Superior Court* (2006) 143 Cal.App.4th 155, 1562.) Any conversations that Plaintiff had with Attorney Jose Sanchez are not privileged or private with respect to Plaintiff. (SEE *D.I. Chadbourne, Inc. v. Superior Court* (1964) 60 Cal.2d 723, 736-737.) The fact that certain complaints were allegedly made by Plaintiff to Jose Ramierz in Mr. Ramirez's capacity as an attorney for the City or City Manager are essential elements of Plaintiffs

whistleblower claims. The receipt of a whistleblower complaint is an official act a government employee and is not protected from discovery by claim of privilege. If Mr. Sanchez asserts the privilege or work product doctrine during deposition with regard to other matters to which he is a percipient witness, then the City of Livingston will be estopped from withdrawing the claim of privilege or work product and offering such testimony at trial.
